

Chiron

"As above so below"

The birth chart is a mirror to our mind, just as the world is equally the mirror of our inner experience. When we look in either we find ourselves. Therefore when our world view is divided we see a divided world, both outside ourselves and in the pattern of the chart.



If our world is whole, nothing exists outside us. Therefore nothing acts upon us that is other than us, whether worldly powers or planetary ones.

Chiron represents an astrological image of wholeness. His principle is experienced in three quite distinct ways:

Through healing - making whole

Through the physical nature - the symbolism of the centaur

Through learning - he was the teacher of heroes, courageous and whole hearted

All too often, and particularly in our experience of schooling, we experience not being listened to, not affirmed, not being free to explore or make our own way. We are measured against standards that were not designed to appraise our gifts. We find ourselves judged and dissociated from our feelings. Not knowing how we really feel, we lose our energy and sense of self and therefore self esteem. Too much of this experience, converts our experience of Chiron into a void.

Shifting into a positive relationship with Chiron in the three key areas of making whole, honouring our physical nature and recovering our natural learning process, shifts us into a positive relationship with Chiron, reminds us of our innate completeness and enables us to move into respectful and appreciative relationships with ourselves, the human family and the natural world.

Such relationships were the natural state and value set of people in many so called primitive societies. Their values and skills are now being recovered and preserved, as well as being combined with new advances in areas such as learning theory and brain science. By re examining the birth chart from a Chironian perspective we can build a fresh picture of ourselves and our world.

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
